### **Class Placement**

Class placement will depend on how high your scores are  
on the TABE Test.

Students that test in the high range will be eligible for CCR  
Boot Camp, which is a five-week multi-subject course that  
integrates the Social Studies, Reading, Writing, Science,  
and Math skills necessary to pass the HSE examinations.  
Students will attend classes daily, take practice tests in the  
Learning Lab as the week progresses, and then take the  
official HSE examinations each week. Because of the  
fast-paced nature of this course, perfect attendance, and  
adequate  
placement test scores are required. In-person.

1. Placement Tests Required: TABE Reading & Math placement tests are required. Placement tests are waived for students who have any of the following:
  - Completed and passed English 111 and Math DMA 050 within the past 2 years (grade transcript required),
  - Have a Silver or Gold CRC Career Readiness Certification within the past 2 years (copy of certificate required),
  - Have a 2-year or 4-year degree within the past 5 years (transcript required).
