- Upon completion, candidates will acquire the following certifications:
 - Firefighter (IFSAC)
 - Haz Mat Level 1 Responder (IFSAC)
 - Incident Command System 100 & 200
 - Emergency Vehicle Driver
 - Technical Rescuer (IFSAC)
- Additional training in the following areas:
 - Health and Nutrition
 - Physical Fitness
 - Firefighter Survival
 - Rapid Intervention Team
 - May Day
 - Interview Techniques
- The NCC Firefighter Academy is approximately 18 weeks (six week EMT class typically begins within two weeks of the end of each Firefighter Academy).
