Things to Consider When Taking a Photo

- Does the photo capture the moment or tell the story?
- Convey that this is NCC! Whether it's a NCC shirt, hat, or other identifier.
- Unless you're taking a group shot, make sure subjects of photo are engaged and look natural...not staged.
- Is lighting adequate?
- Remove background clutter; trash Cans, litter, etc. (if possible).
- Move around. Change your angles, get higher or lower.



Use of photos containing students under 18 years old, their parent or guardian **must** sign a talent release prior to the photos being used for publication.
