General/Additional Comments:

Medical assistants are not required by law to hold licensure or certification. With the exception of North Carolina, the eight states mentioned above require the completion of some sort of medical assisting education program to work as a medical assistant or to be delegated certain tasks while working as a medical assistant. As a result, the NCC Medical Assisting program, because of its CAAHEP-accreditation, meets the requirements of these states.
