The resources below are available to NCC students and employees, Early College and CITI High students and employees, high school students in the Career and College Promise program, people living in Nash County communities, and campus visitors.

Handicapped vehicle spaces in parking lots.

Automatic doors at both entrances to the library.

Book stacks that are ADA compliant for wheelchair access.

Assistance for people who can not reach books on shelves.

Assistance with copying and scanning material.

SmartReader for magnifying book pages.

Microsoft Magnifier and Narrator on computers in the library lab.

Proxy library cards for patrons unable to come to the library.
