The Blue Love Scholars Program is specifically designed to help qualifying high school graduates

with tuition assistance. Funding for the Blue Love Scholars Program is contingent on all source of student funds available including state and federal aid, NCC scholarships and other NCC funds. Funding will be awarded in the above order.

# **Eligibility**

- Open to North Carolina residents.
- Must be a recent high school graduate.
- Must complete the FAFSA at fafsa.gov and an NCC Foundation Scholarship Application at www.nashcc.edu/scholarships.
- Must complete at least three courses through the NCC Career and College Promise (CCP) program with a minimum grade of C and 67% completion rate by the time of high school graduation. Must earn at least a 2.8 unweighted GPA in high school.
- Must be continually enrolled full-time (at least 12 credit hours) in the fall and spring semesters in a program of study. Qualifying students are eligible for a maximum of two years of Blue Love Scholars assistance.
- Must maintain satisfactory academic progress standards by maintaining at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA and complete at least 67% of all courses attempted at NCC.
