

Blue Love Scholars Program

Tuition Assistance

Nash Community College is committed to life-long success of its students. The Blue Love Scholars Program is aimed at helping individuals with their educational journey. This program is an effort to help students with the continued increases in college expenses. Applicants could qualify for up to two years of in-state tuition assistance.

Interested students should meet with their high school counselor or home school principal to identify and establish a College Transfer or Career and Technical Education Pathway. Counselors should work with students to submit their NCC application, call 252-451-8244 or email dlguido744@nashcc.edu for assistance.

The Blue Love Scholars Program is specifically designed to help qualifying high school graduates with tuition assistance. Funding for the Blue Love Scholars Program is contingent on all source of student funds available including state and federal aid, NCC scholarships and other NCC funds. Funding will be awarded in the above order.

High School students enrolled in the NCC Career and College Promise program may be eligible for two years of tuition assistance after graduation.

Eligibility

- Open to North Carolina residents.
- Must be a recent high school graduate.
- Must complete the FAFSA at fafsa.gov and an NCC Foundation Scholarship Application at www.nashcc.edu/scholarships.
- Must complete at least three courses through the NCC Career and College Promise (CCP) program with a minimum grade of C and 67% completion rate by the time of high school graduation. Must earn at least a 2.8 unweighted GPA in high school.
- Must be continually enrolled full-time (at least 12 credit hours) in the fall and spring semesters in a program of study. Qualifying students are eligible for a maximum of two years of Blue Love Scholars assistance.
- Must maintain satisfactory academic progress standards by maintaining at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA and complete at least 67% of all courses attempted at NCC.



Did You Know?

- On average, in-state tuition and fees for one full-time community college student are approximately \$1,240 per semester.
- Four-year colleges and universities charge on average, \$7,200 per semester.
- NCC awards over \$200,000 in scholarships each year.
- High School Career and College Promise students earn tuition-free college credit for Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees. These degrees will seamlessly transfer to Nash Community College or participating colleges.



Take advantage of college credit earned while in high school. Make sure credit is applied to an appropriate program by contacting a NCC counselor to explore all available options.
